Quarterly Voter's Meeting Highlights

• Pastor Schoell and the Church Council recommended that the Church Constitution be amended to allow membership changes to be approved at monthly Church Council meetings instead of at Congregational meetings. The reason for the recommendation is to speed up the process of membership changes. No vote was called at this time but will be voted on at the January Voters Meeting.

• The congregation was updated on the progress of the repairs being made to the area above the choir loft. The congregation was also notified that the section of roof above the alter area will need to be replaced next spring or summer. Estimates for the roof work are being gathered.

• The Church Council notified the congregation that ideas for communion, such as building a ramp to allow the elderly and handicapped to take communion at the altar, were presented to the Council. After discussion in council, the council voted to continue with communion on the floor as was voted by the congregation at the Annual Voters Meeting in July.
