

## **PRE-K ADDENDUM**

**These protocols are an addition to the school plan and are specific to the Pre-K classrooms.**

### **Availability of Toys and Classroom Materials**

- a. We will remove toys and objects which cannot be easily cleaned or sanitized between use.
- b. We will temporarily suspend use of water and sensory tables.
- c. Toys will be cleaned or sanitized regularly. Toys will be cleaned or sanitized before being moved from one classroom to another.
- d. Paper-based children's books are not considered a high risk for transmission by the CDC and do not need additional cleaning or disinfection procedures.

### **Pre-K Snack Time**

- a. Staff will serve a snack to each individual child.
- b. Staff and children will sanitize hands before and immediately after children have eaten

### **Pre-K Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures**

- a. Only one adult per family should be present at drop-off/pick-up. Ideally, this would be the same parent or designated person every day, though we recognize this is not always possible.
- b. Families may be asked to wait in queue before entering the building.
- c. We will provide hand sanitizer or wipes at the sign-in station for parents/guardians to clean pens/keypads between each use.
- d. Parents / caregivers may not enter the classroom at this time.

### **Safety Equipment**

- a. According to the state mandate, Pre-K students are exempt from wearing a face covering.
